

How to measure for blinds for your caravan

Things to Remember

Always use a steel tape for accuracy - make sure the tape measure is straight and tight when you take your measurements.

Always measure in millimetres (mm).

Measure all windows, even those that appear to be the same width and height.

Outside Mounting

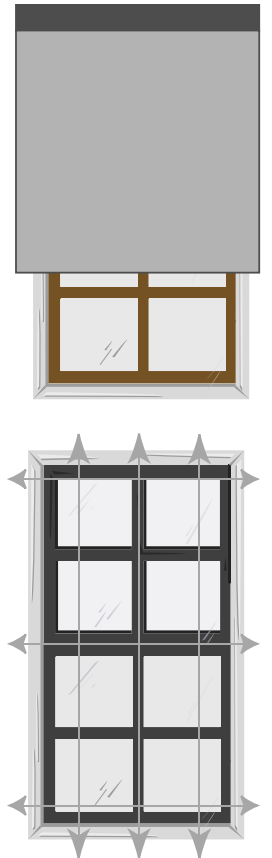
Outside mounted blinds are mounted on the wall or architrave outside the window frame and cover an area larger than the window itself.

Measuring for Outside Mount

Measure the exact width to be covered making sure the measurement overlaps the window to ensure enough light control and privacy.

Measure the exact drop (height) to be covered including any overlap to allow enough space on the wall or architrave to affix the brackets. You can add this overlap to make a small window appear larger, hide unattractive architraves, or to have the blind stack off the window when completely raised.

Please Note: Blinds on Wheels will not take any deductions for an outside mount blind. The blind will be made to the exact measurements specified.



Door mount blinds

Door mount blinds are the same as outside mount blinds, and will be supplied with hold down brackets to secure the bottom of the blind to the door. Make sure the blind that you choose will fit behind door handles and latches when the blind is opened and closed.
